7	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
8	does hereby appoint hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Transgender
9	Civil Rights Implementation Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Resolution No. 102-00,
10	for the term specified:
11	Levi Rena Stolove, succeeding L. J. Irving, (Seat No. 8, must be a member of the
12	transgender community) for the unexpired portions of a two-year term ending June 1, 2002;
13	LeChara Johnson, succeeding Jo Ellen Fisher, (Seat No. 9, must be a member of the
14	transgender community) for the unexpired portions of a two-year term ending June 1, 2002;
15	Melenie Eleneki (residency requirement waived), succeeding Dominique Rosa Leslie,
16	(Seat No. 11, must be a member of the transgender community) for the unexpired
17	portions of a two-year term ending June 1, 2002; and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:
19	1. The membership of the Transgender Civil Rights Implementations Task Force has a
20	goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
21	2. Applicant Melenie Eleneki, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San Francisco,
22	is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the
23	Transgender Civil Rights Implementations Task Force.
24	3. The Transgender Civil Rights Implementations Task Force has attempted to fill the
25	position, for which Melenie Eleneki was nominated, with an individual who is a City

resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Melenie Eleneki is qualified to serve on the Transgender Civil Rights Implementations Task Force. 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Transgender Civil Rights Implementations Task Force at this time; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Melenie Eleneki, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
