WHEREAS, with park benches people can sit down and relax engaging in passive recreation enjoying the open space and the historical architecture of Civic Center Plaza; and

WHERAS, the cost for the benches, installation and maintenance can be offset through a memorial or anonymous bench sponsorship / donation program.

NOW THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Recreation and Park Department to develop a policy to enhance and encourage full utilization of Civic Center Plaza, an important open space resource, by installing a style of bench preferably with armrests.
