4 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is suffering from an epidemic of
5 substance abuse in crisis proportion; and,

6 WHEREAS, Despite the City's treatment on demand policy and other mitigation efforts,
7 we continue to rank number one in the nation in methamphetamine use, number two in LSD,
8 and number three in heroin, as measured by hospital emergency room mentions; and

9 WHEREAS, Teenagers recognize that not all drugs are uniform in addiction or effect,
10 and know hypocrisy when they see it coming from our "baby boom" generation of parents and
11 teachers - including presidential candidates; and,

12 WHEREAS, Unbiased, science-based drug education among young people is crucial
13 to preventing future addiction and related problems; and,

14 WHEREAS, New approaches to improved drug education are needed and available for
15 implementation in schools and other appropriate settings; and,

16 WHEREAS, On Friday, October 29, the San Francisco Medical Society and the
17 Lindesmith Center West will present a statewide landmark conference entitled "Just Say
18 Know: New Directions in Drug Education"; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, The City and County of San Francisco does hereby proclaim Friday,
20 October 29 as Drug Education Day.


