12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
14	Section 96.7, to read as follows:
15	SEC. 96.7. NOTIFICATION TO CLAIMANTS IN POLICE MATTERS. CLAIMS AND
16	LITIGATION ALLEGING POLICE MISCONDUCT.
17	When the City receives a claim alleging improper conduct by a police officer, other than a
18	claim seeking only damages for damage to property resulting from the operation of a Police
19	Department vehicle, the City Attorney shall send the claimant a notice that describes the OCC's role in
20	investigating complaints of police officer misconduct, and includes information on how to contact the
21	<del>OCC.</del>
22	After receiving a claim or lawsuit against the City alleging improper conduct by a police
23	officer, the City Attorney shall send a copy of the claim or lawsuit to the Chief of Police and the
24	Director of the OCC. The City Attorney is not required to send a copy of any lawsuit that includes only
25	allegations previously raised in a claim sent to the Chief and OCC Director. The OCC shall

1	investigate or take other appropriate action regarding the alleged improper conduct, consistent with its
2	duties under the Charter and Police Commission Rules.
