

1 [Provide primary scientific oversight and coordination for ongoing AIDS research studies in  
2 Africa.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, AIDS Office,**  
4 **(SFDPH, AIDS) to enter retroactively into an agreement with the Regents of the**  
5 **University of California San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, to accept and**  
6 **expend funds in the amount of \$11,652 to participate in AIDS prevention studies in**  
7 **Africa, for the period of January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2003.**

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9 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the Department of Health and  
10 Human Services, National Institutes of Health, for the conduct of a program entitled  
11 “International Traineeships in AIDS Prevention Studies (ITAPS)”; and,

12 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of NIH, UCSF, and SFDPH, AIDS to  
13 participate in this program; and,

14 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH, AIDS in the amount of \$11,652  
15 from this award; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH, AIDS to  
17 enter into a subcontract (The “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the  
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of  
19 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$1,248;  
21 now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a  
2 subcontract agreement in the amount of \$11,652 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for  
3 services under the “International Traineeships in AIDS Prevention Studies (ITAPS)” program;  
4 and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
6 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded  
8 under this agreement as a “G” or grant-funded position which would terminate when the  
9 agreement expires.
