16 Letter of Agreement concerning the City's 2002-2003 budget which provides: (a) for the City  
17 to reduce its "pick-up" of the required employee contribution to the retirement system by  
18 2.75% of the employees' compensation effective July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003; (b) a  
19 1% base wage increase effective close of business June 30, 2003 and; (c) a no layoff  
20 commitment in fiscal year 2002-2003 for employees represented by participating employee  
21 organizations.


