14	Section 1. The San F	ancisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending

17	(a) Department of Er	nergency <u>Management</u> Communications; Director. There is
18	hereby created a Departmen	t of Emergency <u>Management</u> <del>Communications</del> . The Mayor shall
19	appoint a Director of Emerge	ncy Management Communications who shall serve as department
20	head and appointing officer for	or the Department. The Director, at the time of appointment, must
21	have a total of at least ten years	of employment or professional service in any of the following
22	disciplines: firefighting, law enf	orcement, public health, or military service, or in the fields of disaster
23	management or emergency prep	aredness and relief at the local, state, or federal level. At least five
24	years of that experience or profe	essional service shall be at a management level. The Director shall

- 2 employees as are authorized pursuant to the budgetary and fiscal provisions of the Charter.
- 3 (b) **Divisions**. The Department shall include two divisions: Emergency Communications and
- 4 *Emergency Services, each headed by a deputy director appointed by the Director of Emergency*
- 5 <u>Management.</u>
- 6 (b) Construction Phase. The Director of Emergency Communications shall be the Project 7 Director for the E 911 Project and shall be responsible for constructing and equipping the City and 8 County's Combined Emergency Communications Center and related systems (also referred to as "the 9 911 communications system facility"). The Director may appoint a deputy Department head to plan the 10 operations of the Combined Emergency Communications Center and related systems. The Director 11 shall certify the completion of the Center and related systems to the Mayor, the Board of Supervisors, 12 the Chief of Police, the Fire Chief and the Director of the Department of Public Health. 13 (c) Emergency Communications Operations Phase. Upon its completion, the Director of 14 *Emergency Communications* The Emergency Communications division of the Department shall manage the Combined Emergency Communications Center and related systems, and shall 15 16 direct all operations related to taking calls from members of the public seeking emergency 17 police, fire and medical assistance and related to the dispatch of emergency police, fire and 18 medical services. The Deputy Director for Emergency Communications shall have a minimum of 19 three years experience in the field of emergency communications, preferably at a management level, including sufficient professional training and/or experience to manage the operations of the 20 21 Combined Emergency Communications Center and related systems. 22 (d) **Emergency Services**. The Emergency Services division of the Department shall be 23 responsible for supporting and overseeing the Emergency Services of San Francisco, as further 24 provided in Chapter 7 of this Code. The Deputy Director for Emergency Services shall have a
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1	minimum of three years experience in the field of emergency preparedness and relief, preferably at a
2	management level.
3	(d) Transfer of Functions. All City and County programs and staff related to emergency
4	services call-taking and dispatch shall be transferred to the Department of Emergency
5	Communications. The duties imposed on the Director of Emergency Communications by Subsection (c)
6	and the transfer of programs and staff to the Department of Emergency Communications shall be
7	effective upon the date the Director certifies the completion of the E 911 Project pursuant to Subsection

5	disaster councils within this metropolitan area, in order that coordination of the work of the
6	Disaster Council with the State Emergency Council and other disaster councils may be had.
7	The <i>Deputy</i> Director shall serve as the Executive Secretary of the City and County Disaster
8	Council and shall have such other powers and duties as may be assigned by the Mayor. The
9	compensation of the <u>Deputy</u> Director shall be fixed in accordance with the fiscal and budgetary
10	provisions of the Charter.
