

3 Resolution proclaiming August 6, 2011, as Salvadoran's Day in the City and County of San Francisco acknowledging the Salvadorian contributions in the Bay Area.

4 WHEREAS, On August 6, 2011, the Coalition for the Salvadoran Day Festival holds its  
5 Bay Area celebration festival in the city of Oakland, California to promote Salvadoran culture,  
6 traditions, and identity; and

8 WHEREAS, Salvadorans constitute a significantly growing population in the Bay Area,  
9 with the majority living in the Counties of San Francisco, San Mateo, Alameda, Contra Costa,  
10 and Santa Clara; and,

11 WHEREAS, The lives, work, and artistry of Salvadoran-Americans have added  
12 strength and vitality to the characteristics that make the United States the multicultural  
13 country it is; and,

14 WHEREAS, Salvadoran families, communities, and generations that follow are  
15 committed to maintain both Salvadoran and American cultures, simultaneously promoting  
16 cultural interchange; and,

17 WHEREAS, Salvadoran Day was established by House of Representatives Resolution  
18 721 in 2006 to celebrate Salvadoran identity and contributions to the United States on August  
19 6 of every year; and,

20 WHEREAS, Salvadoran individuals, families, organizations, and communities across  
21 the Bay Area wish to share the establishment of a nationally recognized and celebrated  
22 Salvadoran Day, to be celebrated by all generations to follow; and,

23 WHEREAS, August 6 is a day of recognition for Salvadorans to celebrate throughout  
24 the United States; now therefore be it

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RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of San Francisco honors Salvadoran's Day in recognition of all Salvadorans living in the City and County of San Francisco for their hard work, dedication, and contribution to the stability and well-being of the community; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby declares August 6, 2011 to be designated as Salvadoran's Day.
