REQUESTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD DRAFT A LETTER OF INQUIRY TO SENATORS DIANNE FEINSTEIN AND BARBARA BOXER AND CONGRESSWOMAN NANCY PELOSI TO INVESTIGATE THE DENIAL OF CONTRACTS TO DAVIES MEDICAL GROUP AND THE DENIAL OF THE ENROLLMENT OF SEVEN GAY AND LESBIAN PHYSICIANS INTO BROWN AND TOLAND MEDICAL GROUP.

WHEREAS, The former Davies Medical Center and its medical staff have provided the highest quality care to patients with HIV/AIDS living in the San Francisco Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, Due to serious financial problems, Davies Medical Center was acquired by California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC), an affiliate of Sutter Health System; and

WHEREAS, The decision approving the acquisition by CPMC was granted by the State Attorney General, the Federal Trade Commission, and the San Francisco Health Commission; and

WHEREAS, The approval by the San Francisco Health Commission was based on the promise by Dr. Martin Brotman, Chief Executive Officer of CPMC that the former Davies Medical Center would continue serving HIV/AIDS patients and that allow access to HMO contracts through Brown and Toland Medical Group (BTMG), the largest independent Physician Association in San Francisco and

WHEREAS, Davies Medical Group, which includes many world renowned experts on the treatment and care of people with HIV/AIDS, had applied and were denied contracts from PacifiCare, Health Net, Blue Shield, and Prudential; and

WHEREAS, Most recently, BTMG invited seven physicians from the Davies Medical Group while simultaneously denying seven other physicians; and

WHEREAS, The seven physicians that were denied, Doctors Drennan, Dyner, Kapla, Lippe, Liskey, Owen and Price, are all members of the Gay and Lesbian community and care for 90% of the HIV/AIDS patients at the Davies Campus of CPMC; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco requests that the Clerk of the Board draft a letter of inquiry urging Senators Dianne Fienstein and Barbara Boxer, as well as Congresswoman Nancy Pelosi to investigate the denial of contracts to Davies Medical Center and allegations of discrimination based on HIV status; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors urges an inquiry into the denial of inclusion of seven gay and lesbian physicians into the Brown and Toland Medical Group.
