2 **Resolution approving the application for grant funds for the Urban Greening Grant**  
3 **Program under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River**  
4 **and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) for Boedekker Park.**  
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6 WHEREAS, The Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided  
7 funds for the program shown above; and

8 WHEREAS, The Strategic Growth Council has been delegated the responsibility for the  
9 administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

10 WHEREAS, Said procedures established by the Strategic Growth Council require a  
11 resolution certifying the approval of application by the Applicant's governing board before  
12 submission of said application to the State; and

13 WHEREAS, The applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of  
14 California to carry out the Project; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
16 approves the filing of an application for the Boedekker Park; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant  
18 understands the assurances and certification in the application, and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant or title  
20 holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project consistent with the land  
21 tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that it will comply with  
23 the provisions of Section 1771.8 of the State Labor Code regarding payment of prevailing  
24 wages on Projects awarded Proposition 50 Funds; and be it

5 will have been obtained; and be it

6           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant will work  
7 towards the Governor’s State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the  
8 economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in  
9 Government Code Section 65041.1; and be it

10          FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors appoints the General Manager  
11 for Recreation and Parks Department, or designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations,  
12 execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreements,  
13 payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the  
14 aforementioned project(s).
