10 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant  
11 funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the  
12 grant budget; now, therefore, be it"

13 WHEREAS, San Francisco was awarded twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from  
14 the Open Society Institute Soros Foundation; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to  
16 retroactively accept and expend \$25,000 from the Open Society Institute of the Soros  
17 Foundation for the purpose of exploring potential alternatives to the California Youth  
18 Authority/Division of Juvenile Justice for San Francisco youth.

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
20 indirect costs in the grant budget.


