

1 [Improve primary care services to the transgendered community, particularly
2 to individuals of color, by providing transgender cultural competency training to providers.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, AIDS Office**
4 **(SFDPH, AIDS) to accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$75,000**
5 **from the Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services**
6 **Administration (DHHS, HRSA) for transgender cultural competency training and to**
7 **enter into an agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of August 1, 2003, to**
8 **July 31, 2004.**

10 WHEREAS, SFDPH, AIDS has been awarded a grant from DHHS,HRSA in the amount
11 of \$75,000 for transgender cultural competency training; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, DHHS,HRSA requires the City
13 to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
14 Board of Supervisors in File No. 040076, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
15 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
17 because we did not receive the grant award notice until August 18, 2003; and,

18 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
19 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
20 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
21 of grant funding; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and
25 expend a grant in the amount of \$75,000 from DHHS, HRSA; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget, and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept and expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires.
