3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$31,724 from the Public Health**
5 **Foundation Enterprises (PHFE), to support a research project entitled**
6 **“Chemoprophylaxis for HIV Prevention in Men;” for the period of February 1, 2008**
7 **through January 31, 2009.**

9 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the J. David Gladstone
10 Institutes to support the research project entitled “Chemoprophylaxis for HIV Prevention in
11 Men;” and,

12 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of the J. David Gladstone Institutes,
13 PHFE, and DPH to collaborate on this project; and,

14 WHEREAS, Through this grant, PHFE has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of
15 \$31,724 for the period of February 1, 2008 through January 31, 2009; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, PHFE requires the City to
17 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. 080911; which is hereby declared to be a part of
19 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
21 for one existing position, Chief Medical Director (Job Class #2237) at .10 FTE, for the period
22 of February 1, 2008 through January 31, 2009; and,

23 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
24 receive the agreement from PHFE until May 16, 2008; and,

1 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$2,884; now
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
4 amount of \$31,724 with PHFE; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
7 be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.


