Luke's Local Inc., in preparation for opening our fourth full-service grocery store within San Francisco at 1266 9th Ave., has requested a TYPE 21 Off-Sale General License. We are applying for a transfer of an existing license. Our application was submitted with the SF ABC office on 12/20/24. We notified neighbors and surrounding businesses by sending out the required ABC mailers on 1/28/25 and posted required signage at the premises on 1/24/25, which will remain up for the 30-day posting period. Our proposed business hours at 1266 9th Ave. will be 8am – 9pm, 7 days/wk.

Luke's Local is a full-service grocery store with our first neighborhood market in Cole Valley having been established in December of 2016, our second at 2190 Union St in Cow Hollow in November of 2020 and our third in North Beach in March of 2023.
