1 (Accept - Expend Grant State Funds)
2 ^{RETROACTIVELY}
3 **AUTHORIZING/THE MUNICIPAL TRANSPORTATION AGENCY TO ACCEPT AND**
4 **EXPEND \$1,800,000 OF STATE ASSISTANCE FOR SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS ON**
5 **MUNICIPAL RAILWAY TRANSIT VEHICLES.**

6 **WHEREAS,** The Governor of California is authorized to make monies available pursuant to
7 the 1999-2000 Budget Act; and

8 **WHEREAS,** The Municipal Transportation Agency, City and County of San Francisco, is
9 an eligible claimant for assistance pursuant to the 1999-00 Budget Act; and

10 **WHEREAS,** The 1999-2000 Budget Act provides for financial assistance to the City and
11 County of San Francisco of \$1,800,000 for the purpose of acquiring and installing surveillance
12 cameras on public transit vehicles of the Municipal Railway; and

13 **WHEREAS,** The Municipal Transportation Agency proposes to maximize use of available
14 grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
15 therefore, be it

16 **RESOLVED,** That the Municipal Transportation Agency is authorized/^{retroactively}to accept and expend
17 \$1,800,000 for the purpose of acquiring and installing surveillance cameras on public transit
18 vehicles of the Municipal Railway; and be it

19 **FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
20 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

21 **FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Municipal Transportation Agency is authorized to
22 furnish whatever additional information might be requested by the funding agencies in connection
23 with this request.


