7 Hospital and Medical Center, he served as Director of Medical Education and Long Term Care
8 from 1963 to 1978 and continued both as Clinical Staff Emeritus at UCSF/ Mt. Zion and
9 Professor Emeritus at UCSF; and,

10 WHEREAS, Dr. Weinstein has been an inspired leader and advocate for the
11 development of quality Homecare services, beginning with his leadership of the San Francisco
12 Demonstration Home Care Program in 1957 and continuing through his tenure as Medical
13 Director of the Mt. Zion Homecare Program from 1961 to 1978, he was the inspiration for the
14 Mt. Zion Housecalls Program which teaches physicians how to care for chronically ill patients
15 in the context of the home environment; and,

16 WHEREAS, Over the years, Dr. Weinstein has been recognized for his excellence in
17 teaching, research and community leadership in the field of home health. Planning for Elders
18 has created an award in his honor which will continue in future years in recognition of
19 outstanding leadership in the arena of home and community-based health care services; and




