3 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH, POPULATION HEALTH AND
4 PREVENTION, TO ACCEPT RETROACTIVELY AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE
5 AMOUNT OF \$257,053 FROM THE CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND
6 PREVENTION FOR THE EVALUATION OF SCREENING MALES FOR CHLAMYDIA
7 TRACHOMATIS AND TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE
8 PATENT INFRINGEMENT INDEMNIFICATION AND FALSE CLAIMS CLAUSES;
9 PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION OF ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN.

10 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, Population Health and Prevention, has
11 applied for and been awarded a grant from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in the
12 amount of \$257,053 to fund a study for the evaluation of screening males for chlamydia
13 trachomatis; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Centers for Disease Control
15 and Prevention requires the City to enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which
16 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 992078 ; and,

17 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has indicated that it will not
18 agree to any modification to the form of the Agreement; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Agreement does not contain certain provisions described below, which
20 are required under the Administrative Code unless waived by the Board of Supervisors; now,
21 therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Department of Public Health is hereby authorized to accept
23 retroactively and expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section
24 10.170-1; and, be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it


1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement
2 contained in Sections 6.21 and 21.19 of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include an
3 indemnification of the City for the infringement of patent rights; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the requirement
5 contained in Section 6.57 (c) of the Administrative Code that the Agreement include a paragraph
6 reciting the false claim provisions contained in Section 6.57 (a) of the Administrative Code; and,
7 be it




8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of
9 Health to enter into similar agreements with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention if
10 the grant recurs or is renewed; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, The Controller should be urged to designate the positions
12 created under the grant as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the grant
13 expires.




