11	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors provided in Section 11.1 of the administrative		
12	provisions of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 Annual Appropriation Ordinance that approv		
13	of recurring grant funds contained in departmental budget submissions and approved in the		
14	FY2025-2026 budget are deemed to meet the requirements of the Administrative Code		
15	regarding grant approvals, and this grant award from the California Department of		
16	Insurance was included in the FY2025-2026 budget submission from the Office of the		
17	District Attorney and approved by the Board of Supervisors in the FY2025-2026 budget;

19	WHEREAS, The Department of Insurance of the State of California, the entity		
20	awarding these grant funds to the Office of the District Attorney, requires documentation of		
21	the Board of Supervisors' approval of their award of grant funds under Automobile-		
22	California Insurance Code, Section 1872.8 and California Code of Regulations, Title 10,		
23	Sections 2698.60 et seq.; and		
24	WHEREAS, The Office of the District Attorney applied for funding from the California		
25	Department of Insurance for the "Automobile Insurance Fraud Program" and was awarded

WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support enhanced investigation and prosecution of automobile insurance fraud cases, and to support the application and subsequent reporting that the Office of the District Attorney must submit to the state as a condition of receiving these funds, as set forth in the California Insurance Code, Section 1872.8 and California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 2698.60s et seq.; and WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary

WHEREAS, The grant includes indirect costs of \$21,802; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively authorizes the Office of the District Attorney to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, a grant from the California Department of Insurance for the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program to be funded in part from funds made available through California Insurance Code, Section 1872.8 and California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Sections 2698.60 et seq., in the amount of \$347,069, to enhance investigation and prosecution of

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant		
2	Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of		
3	the grant recipient and the authorizing agency, and that the State of California and the		
4	California Department of Insurance disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used		
6	to supplant expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors.
