

1 [Retroactive Accept and Expend State Grant]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to retroactively accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$206,125.00 from the California Integrated Waste**
5 **Management Board for the purpose of increasing Used Motor Oil Recycling and**
6 **Household Hazardous Waste Management.**

8 WHEREAS, The people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil
9 Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and
10 maintaining local used oil collection programs that encourage recycling or appropriate
11 disposal of used oil; and,

12 WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB) has been
13 delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the state, setting up
14 necessary procedures governing application by cities and counties under the program; and,

15 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco will enter into agreement with the
16 State of California for implementation of used oil collection programs; and,

17 WHEREAS, the grant is a non-competitive grant that is available to the City and County
18 of San Francisco from the California Integrated Waste Management Board; and,

19 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$20,612 in the
20 grant budget; and,

21 WHEREAS, This grant does not require an ASO amendment; now, therefore, be it

22 **RESOLVED**, That the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the Department of
23 the Environment to retroactively accept and expend the grant funds; and, be it

24 **FURTHER RESOLVED**, That the Director of the Department of the Environment, or a
25 designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County

1 of San Francisco all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and
2 amendments hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out
3 the purposes specified in the grant application; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the
5 submittal of grant applications to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for all
6 available California Oil Recycling Grants and all available Household Hazardous Waste
7 Grants for the period of FY 2007/08 to FY 2010/11.
