

1 [Double Parking on Municipal Railway Bus Routes Prohibit; Fines]

2 **Ordinance amending Article 3, Chapter XI, Part II, Section 53(a) of the San Francisco**
3 **Traffic Code removing sunset clause.**

8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 53(a). Article 3, Chapter XI of the San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby
10 amended by amending Section 53(a), to read as follows:

11 Sec. 53 Double Parking

12 (a) No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle such that any
13 portion of the vehicle is within the Municipal Railway bus route on restricted streets. The
14 restricted streets are Chestnut Street, Union Street, Clay Street, Stockton Street, Mission
15 Street, Geary Street, Polk Street, Sacramento Street, Clement Street, Fillmore Street, Haight
16 Street, Irving Street, 9th Avenue, 16th Street, and 24th Street. No person shall stop, park, or
17 leave standing in any such portion of a Municipal Railway bus route on such street his or her
18 vehicle between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Any
19 person violating this Section shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00. The Department of Parking
20 and Traffic shall install signs and otherwise alert motorists where and when this prohibition
21 shall take effect and the applicable fine. This section shall not apply to vehicles engaged in
22 emergency services including, but not limited to, fire engines, police vehicles, ambulances, or
23 public utility vehicles while such vehicles are operating, maintaining, or repairing facilities of
24 the public utility or are being used in connection with providing public utility service.
