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| 7 | WHEREAS, The Secretary of Transportation is authorized to make monies available |
| 8 | under the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for mass transportation |
| 9 | projects; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency, City and County of San Francisco, |
| 11 | through its Board of Directors, is an eligible claimant for FTA capital assistance projects under |
| 12 | Section 5309 of TEA-21; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, The grant contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations |
| 14 | upon the applicant, including providing the local share of project costs; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, The local share of project costs will be funded separately using a variety of |
| 16 | sources which may include Regional Bridge Toll Net Revenues, San Francisco Municipal |
| 17 | Railway Improvement Corporation Funds and/or San Francisco County Transportation Sales |
| 18 | Taxes; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, It is required by the U.S. Department of Transportation (U.S. DOT) in |
| 20 | accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection |
| 21 | with the filing of an application for federal assistance, the applicant give an assurance that it |
| 22 | will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the U.S. DOT requirements |
| 23 | thereunder; and |
| 24 | WHEREAS, It is the goal of the applicant that disadvantaged business enterprises be |

utilized to the fullest extent possible in connection with this project, and that definitive

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| 1 | procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that disadvantaged businesses |
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| 2 | shall have the maximum possible opportunity to compete for contracts, supplies, equipment |
| 3 | contracts, or consultant and other services; and |
| 4 | WHEREAS, Congress has earmarked funding in TEA-21 for a national program of |
| 5 | projects using Section 5309 capital assistance; and |
| 6 | WHEREAS, This Municipal Railway project, included in the national program, is a high |
| 7 | priority San Francisco project; now, therefore, be it |
| 8 | RESOLVED, That the MTA Board is authorized to execute and file an application on |
| 9 | behalf of the City and County of San Francisco with the U.S. DOT to aid in the capital |
| 10 | assistance projects pursuant Section 5309 program funding; and, be it |
| 11 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA Board is authorized to execute and file with |
| 12 | such application an assurance or any other document required by the U.S. DOT effectuating |
| 13 | the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and, be it |
| 14 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA Director of Transportation (or his designee) is |
| 15 | authorized to execute any and all agreements necessary to complete transfer of the funds; |
| 16 | and, be it |
| 17 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA Board is authorized to accept and expend |
| 18 | \$990,029 in federal FTA Section 5309 capital assistance for design and construction of |
| 19 | MUNI's Central Control facility; and, be it |
| 20 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA Board is authorized to furnish whatever |
| 21 | additional information might be requested by the funding agencies in connection with this |
| 22 | request; and, be it |
| 23 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the MTA Board is authorized to set forth and execute |
| 24 | affirmative disadvantaged business policies in connection with the project's procurement |
| 25 | needs. |
