2 AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PORTION OF CASTRO STREET.

4 WHEREAS, The Interdepartmental Staff Committee on Traffic and Transportation  
5 (ISCOTT) conducted a public hearing on January 14, 1999, on the application of The Sisters  
6 of Perpetual Indulgence for the temporary closing of one block of Castro Street, between 17<sup>th</sup>  
7 and 18<sup>th</sup> Streets on April 4, 1999, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., to commemorate the 20<sup>th</sup>  
8 Easter Anniversary Celebration of The Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence and recommended  
9 disapproval of said application; and,

10 WHEREAS, On February 11, 1999, a public appeal hearing was held before the  
11 Director, Department of Parking and Traffic and he upheld the decision of ISCOTT and  
12 denied the appeal; and

13 WHEREAS, On February 18, 1999, The Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence appealed the  
14 Director's decision to the Board of Supervisors; and

15 WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code Section 2.70-1, this  
16 Board of Supervisors conducted a hearing on March 1, 1999; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby grants permission to close to  
18 vehicular traffic the following streets:

19 Castro Street, between 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Streets on April 4, 1999, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00  
20 p.m., to commemorate the 20<sup>th</sup> Easter Anniversary Celebration of The Sisters of Perpetual  
21 Indulgence; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That at all times during the period authorized for the  
23 temporary closing and occupancy of said streets, such permission is granted subject to those  
24 conditions containing in Chapter 2, Article VIII, San Francisco Administrative Code, pertaining  
25 to the Temporary Use or Occupancy of Public Streets.
