1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant]

2 AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILDREN YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES TO
3 ACCEPT AND EXPEND A PLANNING GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 FROM THE
4 OFFICE OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION TO DEVELOP A
5 DEMONSTRATION INITIATIVE THAT PREVENTS AND REDUCES THE IMPACT OF
6 FAMILY AND COMMUNITY VIOLENCE ON YOUNG CHILDREN (PRIMARILY FROM BIRTH
7 TO 6 YEARS OF AGE).

9 WHEREAS, the purpose of the San Francisco SafeStart Initiative
10 will be to create a single system out of the multiple systems and
11 fragmented service delivery networks that currently serve children
12 who are witnesses to, or victims of, family violence; and,

13 WHEREAS, the San Francisco SafeStart Initiative \$250,000
14 Planning Grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency
15 Prevention for the 12 month period May 1, 2000 through April 30, 2001
16 will be administered by the Department of Children, Youth, and their
17 Families; and,

18 WHEREAS, in addition to integrating service delivery and
19 assuring that local programs follow research validated models, we
20 will be creating an infrastructure that includes strengthened
21 collaboration, enhanced data integration, expanded resources, and
22 increased community participation and cultural competence. A series
23 of age-appropriate strategies will be implemented in the areas of
24 prevention, early intervention, and intensive intervention; and,

1 WHEREAS, the funds will be used for assessment, planning, and
2 initial development activities; and,

3 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available
4 grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs
5 in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion
7 of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the \$250,000 from the Office of Juvenile
9 Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) is the first allocation of
10 fund; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any subsequent funds from OJJDP for the
12 San Francisco Safe Start Demonstration Project will be appropriated
13 through the Annual Budget Process; and be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco
15 hereby authorizes the Department of Children, Youth, and Their
16 Families to accept and expend the \$250,000 from OJJDP; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge
18 the Controller to designate the two new positions authorized under the
19 grant as "G" or "Grant-funded" positions, which would terminate when
20 the grant expires.


