WHEREAS, in addition to integrating service delivery and assuring that local programs follow research validated models, we will be creating an infrastructure that includes strengthened collaboration, enhanced data integration, expanded resources, and increased community participation and cultural competence. A series of age-appropriate strategies will be implemented in the areas of prevention, early intervention, and intensive intervention; and,
