

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of**
4 **San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the**
5 **amount of \$235,252 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of**
6 **Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) for a program entitled**
7 **"COPSmeth 2007 San Francisco".**

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9 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police for the City and County of San
10 Francisco desires to undertake a certain project designated "COPSmeth
11 2007 San Francisco", to be funded from funds made available through
12 the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing
13 Services (COPS); and,

14 WHEREAS, The intent of this program will be to disrupt and
15 interdict the distribution channels for methamphetamine coming into
16 the county and San Francisco Airport, identify mid-level
17 methamphetamine dealers, identification and destruction of
18 methamphetamine labs, focus on the well-being of children, increase
19 child endangerment referrals for prosecution, increase counties
20 health prevention efforts related to HIV and methamphetamine, and
21 augment resources and add efficiency to our existing County's Crystal
22 Methamphetamine Task Force; and,

23 WHEREAS the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

24 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in
25 the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

2 San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San
3 Francisco to retroactively accept and expend continued funding for
4 this project from the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of
5 Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS); and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and
7 County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the
8 City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Agreement for
9 this project including any extensions, funding augmentations from the
10 USDOJ/COPS, or amendments thereof; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising
12 out of performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court
13 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and
14 the authorizing agency; and be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not
16 be used to supplant expenditure controlled by the Board of
17 Supervisors.
