| 1 | Section 1. The San Francisco Planning Code is hereby amended by adding Section |
| 2 | 296, to read as follows: |

| 4 | (a) No building permit authorizing the construction of any structure that will cast |
| 5 | any shade or shadow upon the site of a public or private elementary or secondary school may be issued |
| 6 | except upon prior action of the City Planning Commission pursuant to the provisions of this Section; |
| 7 | provided, however, that the provisions of this Section shall not apply to building permits authorizing: |
| 8 | (1) Structures which do not exceed 40 feet in height; |
| 9 | (2) Structures which cast a shade or shadow upon the site of a public or private |

| 1 | (b) The City Planning Commission shall conduct a hearing and shall disapprove the |

| 4 | because of the shading or shadowing that it will cause, unless it is determined that the impact would be |
