16	Nutcracker® in 1985; and
17	WHEREAS, Along with a resume of regular dance and fundraising events, City Swing
18	has performed for a wide array of special invitation events; and
19	WHEREAS, In 1986, the band was honored to be declared by the Board of Supervisors
20	the City of San Francisco's "Goodwill Ambassadors" to the 1986 World Expo in Vancouver;

22	WHEREAS, In 1988, City Swing performed at City Hall for the Mayor's Inaugural Ball,
23	and in 2000, City Swing was flown to Palm Springs as the centerpiece of a gala benefit for the
24	AIDS Assistance Program; and

2	O'Brien, providing WWII-era music for this National Liberty Ship Memorial on its annual Fleet
3	Week cruise on the Bay; and

5	Ball of the Imperial Court of San Francisco; now, therefore be it
