3 **Resolution approving the application for grant funds for the Urban Greening Grant**  
4 **program under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River**  
5 **and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) for the Mission Creek Park**

8 WHEREAS, The Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided  
9 funds for the program shown above; and

10 WHEREAS, The Strategic Growth Council has been delegated the responsibility for the  
11 administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

12 WHEREAS, Said procedures established by the Strategic Growth Council require a  
13 resolution certifying the approval of application by the Applicant's governing board before  
14 submission of said application to the State; and

15 WHEREAS, The applicant, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the State of  
16 California to carry out the Project; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
18 approves the filing of an application for the Mission Creek Park Corridor and Community  
19 Gardens; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant  
21 understands the assurances and certification in the application; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant or title  
23 holder will have sufficient funds to operate and maintain the project consistent with the land  
24 tenure requirements; or will secure the resources to do so; and, be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that it will comply with

1 the provisions of Section 1771.8 of the State Labor Code regarding payment of prevailing  
2 wages on Projects awarded Proposition 50 Funds; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that, if applicable, the  
4 project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, legal  
5 requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access laws,  
6 environmental laws and, that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits  
7 will have been obtained; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors certifies that applicant will work  
9 towards the Governor's State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the  
10 economy, protect the environment, and promote public health and safety as included in  
11 Government Code Section 65041.1; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors appoints the Director of the  
13 Office of Economic and Workforce Development, or designee, as agent to conduct all  
14 negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications,  
15 agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the  
16 aforementioned project(s).
