(GRANT - COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT)

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF DEPARTMENT OF PARKING AND TRAFFIC AND THE DIRECTOR OF DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND UP TO \$331,000 IN STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDS AS REIMBURSEMENT FOR REVIEW AND ASSISTANCE TO STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS) IN THE PREPARATION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE I-80 WESTERN APPROACHES PROJECTS, AS WELL AS TECHNICAL CONSULTATION, AND ASSISTANCE ON PUBLIC OUTREACH AS REQUESTED BY CALTRANS.

WHEREAS, The concrete section of the Western Approaches of the I-80, Bay Bridge from the West Anchorage to 5th Street, was weakened during the 1989 Loma Prieta earthquake; and,

WHEREAS, The State has a plan to retrofit and rebuild that portion of the Freeway; and,

WHEREAS, Department of Parking and Traffic and Department of Public Works staff worked closely with CALTRANS, MUNI, local businesses and residents, on a day-to-day basis, to coordinate all plans and designs for all temporary detours on City streets as part of the demolition and reconstruction of that portion of the Freeway; and ,

WHEREAS, Indirect overhead costs are not allowed by the Federal Highway Administration; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic and the Director of Public Works are authorized to accept and expend up to \$331,000 in State and Federal funds as reimbursement for the planning and design of the Traffic Mitigation Plan (TMP) as required for the retrofitting and reconstruction of I-80, Western Approach of the Bay Bridge; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That, although the City has incurred no legal obligation, the Board of Supervisors does hereby ratify that action previously taken.

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller should be urged to designate the positions created under the grant as "G" or Grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the grant expires.
