TRANSFERRING THE STAFF SERVING THE DELINQUENCY PREVENTION

COMMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO THE

MAYOR'S OFFICE OF CHILDREN, YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES.

WHEREAS, The City has established a Delinquency Prevention Commission consisting of 19 members as provided in Administrative Code Section 20.50 and following sections; and,

WHEREAS, Section 20.52 of the Administrative Code provides "The Board may designate" the City and County department or departments to provide staff service to the Commission where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, The appropriate organizational location of the Delinquency Prevention Commission and its staff has been the subject of concern and analysis for many years; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Legislative Analyst of the Board of Supervisors recently issued a report concerning the organizational location of the Delinquency Prevention Commission and its staff; and

WHEREAS, In other major counties in California the Delinquency Prevention

Commission is often a joint commission with the Juvenile Justice Commission or is a standing committee of the Children, Youth and Family Commission and is staffed by the Probation Department or the Juvenile Justice Commission or the Health and Human Services staff; and

WHEREAS, The Delinquency Prevention Commission performs useful functions for San Franciscans; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors desires the Delinquency Prevention

Commissioners to continue to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and continue to report to the Board of Supervisors; and

Supervisors Kaufman, Brown

WHEREAS, The staff of the Delinquency Prevention Commission consists of a Class 1366 Special Assistant VII and a Class 1361 Special Assistant II, both appointed by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, The Delinquency Prevention Commission staff is not appropriately within the legislative branch of the city government but instead should be within the executive branch; and

WHEREAS, The offices of the Delinquency Prevention Commission and the Mayor's Office of Children Youth and Their Families are both on the 9<sup>th</sup> Floor of the building at 1390 Market Street, known as Fox Plaza; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families is fully qualified to provide coordination of its functions and services to the Delinquency Prevention Commission; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the members of the Delinquency Prevention Commission shall continue to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors; and shall continue to report to the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby designates the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families to provide staff service to the Delinquency Prevention Commission; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the staff of the Delinquency Prevention Commission is hereby transferred from the Department of the Board of Supervisors to the Mayor's Office of Children Youth and Their Families; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That unless the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families determines otherwise, the staff providing service to the Delinquency Prevention Commission shall be housed as it is now in Room 901 at 1390 Market Street; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller and the Director of Human Resources are

requested to make the appropriate administrative adjustments to the City's appropriations and position allocations to carry out the intent of this resolution; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative on September 5, 1998, or at the beginning of the first pay period after the effective date of this resolution, whichever first occurs.
