

1 [Delinquency Prevention Commission]
2 TRANSFERRING THE STAFF SERVING THE DELINQUENCY PREVENTION
3 COMMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO THE
4 MAYOR'S OFFICE OF CHILDREN, YOUTH AND THEIR FAMILIES.

6 WHEREAS, The City has established a Delinquency Prevention Commission
7 consisting of 19 members as provided in Administrative Code Section 20.50 and following
8 sections; and,

9 WHEREAS, Section 20.52 of the Administrative Code provides "The Board may
10 designate the City and County department or departments to provide staff service to the
11 Commission where appropriate; and

12 WHEREAS, The appropriate organizational location of the Delinquency Prevention
13 Commission and its staff has been the subject of concern and analysis for many years; and

14 WHEREAS, the Chief Legislative Analyst of the Board of Supervisors recently issued a
15 report concerning the organizational location of the Delinquency Prevention Commission and
16 its staff; and

17 WHEREAS, In other major counties in California the Delinquency Prevention
18 Commission is often a joint commission with the Juvenile Justice Commission or is a standing
19 committee of the Children, Youth and Family Commission and is staffed by the Probation
20 Department or the Juvenile Justice Commission or the Health and Human Services staff; and

21 WHEREAS, The Delinquency Prevention Commission performs useful functions for
22 San Franciscans; and

23 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors desires the Delinquency Prevention
24 Commissioners to continue to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors and continue to
25 report to the Board of Supervisors; and

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

1 WHEREAS, The staff of the Delinquency Prevention Commission consists of a Class
2 1366 Special Assistant VII and a Class 1361 Special Assistant II, both appointed by the Clerk
3 of the Board of Supervisors; and

4 WHEREAS, The Delinquency Prevention Commission staff is not appropriately within
5 the legislative branch of the city government but instead should be within the executive
6 branch; and

7 WHEREAS, The offices of the Delinquency Prevention Commission and the Mayor's
8 Office of Children Youth and Their Families are both on the 9th Floor of the building at 1390
9 Market Street, known as Fox Plaza; and

10 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their Families is fully qualified
11 to provide coordination of its functions and services to the Delinquency Prevention
12 Commission; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the members of the Delinquency Prevention Commission shall
14 continue to be appointed by the Board of Supervisors; and shall continue to report to the
15 Board of Supervisors; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby designates the Mayor's
17 Office of Children, Youth and Their Families to provide staff service to the Delinquency
18 Prevention Commission; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the staff of the Delinquency Prevention Commission is
20 hereby transferred from the Department of the Board of Supervisors to the Mayor's Office of
21 Children Youth and Their Families; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That unless the Mayor's Office of Children, Youth and Their
23 Families determines otherwise, the staff providing service to the Delinquency Prevention
24 Commission shall be housed as it is now in Room 901 at 1390 Market Street; and, be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller and the Director of Human Resources are

1 requested to make the appropriate administrative adjustments to the City's appropriations and
2 position allocations to carry out the intent of this resolution; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative on September 5,
4 1998, or at the beginning of the first pay period after the effective date of this resolution,
5 whichever first occurs.
