14	participate in this project; and,		
15	WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$93,523 under

17	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH to enter into a		
18	subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
19	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this		
20	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
21	WHEREAS, The contract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$10,020; now,		
22	therefore, be it		
23	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract		
24	agreement in the amount of \$93,523 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for AIDS surveillance		
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1	training materials, field testing, and providing technical assistance as defined under this		
2	agreement, and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
4	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions		
6	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate whe		
7	the agreement expires.
