10	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
11	Section 1. Findings
12	The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this
13	Ordinance are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
14	Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
15	Board of Supervisors in File Noand is incorporated herein by
16	reference.
17	Section 2. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
18	Section 2A.270, to read as follows:
19	SEC. 2A.270. ECONOMIC AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.
20	(a) Economic and Workforce Development Department. There shall be an
21	Economic and Workforce Development Department. The Mayor shall appoint a Director who
22	shall serve as department head and appointing officer for the Department. The Director shall
23	serve at the pleasure of the Mayor. The Department shall include such officers and
24	employees as are authorized pursuant to the budgetary and fiscal provisions of the Charter.
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1	(b) <b>Duties and Functions.</b> The Department shall be responsible for economic and
2	workforce development, including, among other things:
3	(1) attracting, retaining and assisting businesses;
4	(2) strengthening the economic vitality of neighborhoods and commercial corridors;
5	(3) restoring contaminated sites to productive reuse ("brownfields");
6	(4) fostering international trade;
7	(5) developing and implementing workforce development and jobs training programs;
8	(6) coordinating major City projects, including public-private partnerships and military
9	base conversions;
10	(7) administering the City's public debt and related public finance matters;
11	(8) processing the forms and supporting documentation submitted by employers to establish
12	eligibility for San Francisco Enterprise Zone tax credits established under California Administrative
13	Code Title 25, Division 1, Chapter 7, Subchapter 21, Enterprise Zone Program; and
14	(9)(8) such other duties and functions as assigned pursuant to the Charter or by
15	ordinance.
16	(c) Fee to process forms for San Francisco Enterprise Zone tax credits. The Department is
17	authorized to charge a fee of \$80 for each form and supporting documentation submitted by an
18	employer to establish eligibility for San Francisco Enterprise Zone tax credits established under
19	California Administrative Code Title 25, Division 1, Chapter 7, Subchapter 21, Enterprise Zone
