

1 [Apply for State Grant – Sheriff’s Department project to address the needs of mentally ill
offenders in the jails.]

2 **Resolution authorizing the Sheriff’s Department to apply for a 18-month grant in an**
3 **amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 from the Corrections Standards Authority for the**
4 **Mentally Ill Offenders Crime Reduction (MIOCR) Grant Program.**

6 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is seeking state funds
7 available through the Mentally Ill Offender Crime Reduction (MIOCR) grant program
8 administered by the Corrections Standards Authority (hereafter referred to as CSA), and,

9 WHEREAS, The State requires that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Sheriff
10 to apply for such funding; and,

11 WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Department proposes to maximize use of available grant
12 funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs; now, therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby waive indirect costs; and
14 be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Sheriff to submit
16 the MIOCR application on behalf of the county and to sign the Grant Agreement with the
17 CSA, including any amendments thereof, on behalf of the county; and be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, The City and County of San Francisco assures that it will
19 provide all matching funds required for the MIOCR grant subject to the annual budget
20 process; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will not use
22 grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco assures that it
2 will abide by the statutes governing the MIOCR grant program as well as the terms and
3 conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the CSA.
