

1 [Identify barriers to accessing preventive oral health care among various ethnic/racial  
2 caregivers of children in San Francisco between 1 and 5 years of age.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFPDH) to**  
5 **enter retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$93,537 with The Regents of the**  
6 **University of California (UCR), the primary contractor, to understand ethnic/racial**  
7 **cultural differences related to children’s oral health, under the first year of an award**  
8 **from the National Institutes of Health (NIH); for the period of September 1, 2001 to July**  
9 **31, 2002.**

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11 WHEREAS, UCR is the recipient of a grant from NIH for the conduct of a program titled  
12 “Center to Address Disparities in Children’s Oral Health”; and,

13 WHEREAS, it is considered in the best interests of NIH, UCR, and SFPDH to  
14 participate in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, UCR has agreed to reimburse SFPDH in the amount of \$93,537 for the  
16 first year of the award; and

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCR requires the SFPDH to enter  
18 into a subcontract (The “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
19 Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as  
20 if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$3,049;  
22 now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the SFPDH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a  
24 subcontract agreement in the amount of \$93,537 with UCR, the primary contractor; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
2 Agreement on behalf of the City.

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the .167 FTE Clerk position shall be designated as a  
4 grant "G" position and the authority for this position shall terminate when the agreement  
5 terminates.
