14	WHEREAS, On August 16, 2023, the Department of Children, Youth and Their
15	Families issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for its 2024–2029 funding cycle; and
16	WHEREAS, Community Youth Center of San Francisco submitted proposals for four
17	programs under RFP Result Area: All Children And Youth Are Ready To Learn And Succeed
18	In School; and
19	WHEREAS, The four programs are: Academic Support; Beacon at Aptos; Year-Round
20	& Summer Programs; and Teen Arts; and
21	WHEREAS, Community Youth Center of San Francisco was awarded funding in all
22	four programs; and
23	WHEREAS, Under the Academic Support Program, Community Youth Center of San
24	Francisco will provide academic coaching, tutoring and educational support for 60 youth at
25	Aptos Middle School, Balboa and San Francisco International High Schools; and

1 WHEREAS, Under the Beacon at Aptos Program, Community Youth Center of San 2 Francisco will provide beacon program framework that is student-centered, grounded in 3 partnership and focused on the needs of students, families and the school community; and 4 WHEREAS, Under the Year-Round and Summer Programs, Community Youth Center 5 of San Francisco will provide services to a total of 640 youth from kindergarten to high school 6 through comprehensive programs tailored to address Summer Learning Loss; and 7 WHEREAS, Under the Teen Arts Program, Community Youth Center of San Francisco 8 will provide programming for multiple cohorts of 18 youth, totaling 90 youth, in the disciplines 9 of film and music production, screen-printing, pottery, dance, photography, digital media and 10 DIY art studio; and 11 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by 12 Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any 13 contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and 14 WHEREAS, The proposed Agreement contained in File No. , is substantially in 15 final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by 16 the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it 17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Agreement in 18 substantially the form contained in File No. ; and, be it FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes Department of 19 20 Children, Youth and Families to make any modifications to the Agreement, prior to its final 21 execution by all parties, that Department of Children, Youth and Their Families determines, in 22 consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of 23 the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or 24 advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Agreement, and are in compliance with all 25 applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it
