3 4	Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a
5	grant in the amount of \$250,000 from the California State Coastal Conservancy for
6	habitat restoration and trail improvements in Glen Canyon Park, approving the
7	allocation of capital funds from the Neighborhood Park Bond for matching funds,
8	waiving inclusion of indirect costs, authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to
9	negotiate agreements with the California Coastal Conservancy, and requiring Board
10 11	Committee approval of the Glen Park project conceptual plan before these grant funds
12	are expended for construction, changes in use, or tree or foliage removal.
13	WHEREAS, Glen Canyon Park is a designated significant natural resource area that supports
14	locally important plant animal habitats; and
15	WHEREAS, The ecological health and recreational opportunities in the Glen Canyon Natural
16	Area are threatened by the expansion of invasive noxious weeds and erosion; and
17	WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department requires additional funds to make
18	improvements to the natural area; and
19	WHEREAS, In discussion with the community the Department has agreed to follow the
20 21	Recreation and Park Department's public participation process for capital plans, provide facilitators for
22	public meetings, and address issues of pedestrian circulation in the park; and
23	WHEREAS, because of the exceptional nature of this project, the Recreation and Park
24	Department has agreed to present the Recreation and Park Commission approved
25	conceptual plan for the Glen Canyon project to the Board of Supervisors' Neighborhood

Services and Parks Committee, or any successor committee, for its approval before any
expenditure of California State Coastal Conservancy grant funds for construction, change in use or tree
or foliage removal; and
WHEREAS, The California State Legislature has established the State Coastal Conservancy and
authorized it to award grants to nine Bay Area Counties to improve public access, restore natural
habitats and promote educational and recreational opportunities in urban areas; and
WHEREAS, The grants are awarded pursuant to guidelines established by the California
Coastal Conservancy for determination of project eligibility for funds; and
WHEREAS, The procedures established by the California Coastal Conservancy require the
applicant to certify by resolution approval of the application prior to submission to the State; and
WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department proposed to maximize use of available grant
funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; and
WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$250,000 are required pursuant to this grant.
Thus total project costs for the Glen Canyon Park Project are \$500,000; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby: 1) approve the
acceptance and expenditure of funding under the State Coastal Conservancy's San Francisco Bay
Program, 2) approve the allocation of capital funds from the Neighborhood Park Bond to provide
required matching funds, 3) waive inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget and 4) authorize the
Recreation and Park Department to negotiate and execute all agreements necessary to comply with the
California Coastal Conservancy's requirements; and be it
FURTHER RESOLVED, That before the Recreation and Park Department expends any
California State Coastal Conservancy grant funds for construction, changes in

1	use or tree or foliage removal, it shall present the Recreation and Park Commissions' conceptual
2	plan for the Glen Canyon project to the Board of Supervisors' Neighborhood Services and Parks
3	Committee for its review and approval.
