

1 [Grant to support Laguna Honda Hospital’s Activity Therapy Department.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), Laguna**  
4 **Honda Hospital (LHH) to retroactively accept and expend a grant for \$35,000, from the**  
5 **James Irvine Foundation, the Walter and Elise Haas Fund, and the Flora Hewlett**  
6 **Foundation, through the Creative Work Fund, and to enter into a subcontract with artist**  
7 **Helena Keeffe; for the period of September 1, 2007 through August 31, 2008.**

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9 WHEREAS, LHH was awarded a grant for \$35,000 to fund a project that is a  
10 collaboration between artist, Helena Keeffe and the LHH Activity Therapy Department that will  
11 involve LHH residents in drawing and printmaking workshops from September 1, 2007  
12 through August 31, 2008; and,

13 WHEREAS, Designs will be selected from the collected works of resident art and  
14 transferred to professionally printed and sewn linens and scrubs with the linen made available  
15 for residents to use on beds and scrubs sold and LHH’s Gift Shop; and,

16 WHEREAS, LHH will provide the full amount of the grant plus additional funds to  
17 reimburse for reproduction costs of the grant application, for a total of \$35,200, to the artist  
18 who conceptualized and will lead the project, Helena Keeffe; and,

19 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Creative Work Fund  
20 require the City to comply with the terms of an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which  
21 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 071198, which is hereby  
22 declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

23 WHEREAS, This grant does not require an ASO amendment because no staffing costs  
24 are involved; and,

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1           WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,  
2 therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That DPH/LHH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend  
4 this grant in the amount of \$35,000 from the Creative Work Fund; and, be it

5           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
6 indirect costs in the budget of the two Agreements; and, be it

7           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
8 Agreement on behalf of the City.
