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3	Ordinance amending the Transportation Code, Division I, Section 4.4, to authorize the
4	Service Authority for the Abatement of Abandoned Vehicles (the San Francisco
5	Municipal Transportation Agency Board) to extend the \$1 abandoned vehicle
6	abatement fee on all vehicles registered to City residents for ten years, from June 1,
7	2013 through May 31, 2023, and making environmental findings.

12	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
13	Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
14	this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
15	Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
16	Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by reference.
17	Section 2. The Transportation Code, Division I, is hereby amended by amending
18	Section 4.4, to read as follows:
19	SEC. 4.4. SERVICE AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED.
20	(a) A Service Authority for the Abatement of Abandoned Vehicles is hereby
21	established pursuant to the provisions of Section 22710 of the <i>California</i> Vehicle Code. The
22	members of the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors shall serve ex officio as
23	the members of the Service Authority for the Abatement of Abandoned Vehicles. Except as
24	otherwise provided in this Article $\underline{47}$, the Service Authority shall have all of the powers and be

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1	subject to all of the conditions, restrictions and obligations that are set forth in <u>said</u> Section
2	22710 of the California Vehicle Code.
3	(b) Extension Imposition of the a service fee of \$1 on vehicles registered to an
4	owner with an address in the City and County of San Francisco for deposit in the Abandoned
5	Vehicle Trust Fund, as permitted by Section 9250.7 (a) of the Vehicle Code, is hereby
6	approved, and the Service Authority for the Abatement of Abandoned Vehicles is authorized
7	to enact a resolution extending imposing such service fee for a ten-year period, from June 1,
8	2013 through May 31, 2023, pursuant to said Section 9250.7(g).
9	Section 3. Effective and Operative Dates. The effective date of this ordinance shall be
10	the 30 th day after its enactment. The operative date of the ordinance shall be June 1, 2013. If
11	the effective date occurs after the operative date, the ordinance shall be retroactive to June 1,
12	2013.
13	Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
14	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
15	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the
16	Transportation Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board
17	amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that
18	appears under the official title of the ordinance.
19	Section 5. Pursuant to Section 9250.7(g) of the California Vehicle Code, passage of
20	this ordinance requires a two-thirds' vote of the Board of Supervisors.
