

1 [Cooperative Agreement - Presidio Trust - Animal Control and Welfare Services]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Animal Care and Control (SFACC) to**
4 **enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the Presidio Trust to provide animal**
5 **control and welfare services for an initial term of five years, with an option to**
6 **extend for an additional five years, effective upon approval of this Resolution;**
7 **and to authorize the SFACC Executive Director to enter into amendments or**
8 **modifications to the Cooperative Agreement that do not materially increase the**
9 **obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes**
10 **of the Cooperative Agreement or this Resolution.**

12 WHEREAS, The Presidio Trust (Trust) is a wholly-owned United States
13 government corporation responsible for administering a portion of the Presidio of San
14 Francisco (Presidio) known as Area B, within the boundaries of the Golden Gate
15 National Recreation Area (GGNRA); and

16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Animal Care and Control (SFACC) is a
17 department under the jurisdiction of the Office of the City Administrator of the City and
18 County of San Francisco and the local agency that provides housing, care, and medical
19 treatment to wild, exotic and domestic stray, lost, abandoned, sick, injured, and
20 surrendered animals; and

21 WHEREAS, The Trust needs assistance with impounding animals under various
22 circumstances within Area B of the Presidio; and

23 WHEREAS, The Trust and SFACC desire to enter into a Cooperative Agreement
24 for SFACC to provide the services of impounding, transporting, and housing animals
25 originating in Area B and to perform other services in Area B; and

1 WHEREAS, The Trust shall pay SFACC for time expended and costs incurred in
2 connection with the services provided under the Cooperative Agreement; and

3 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Charter, Section 9.118 requires the Board of
4 Supervisors to approve agreements having an anticipated term of ten years or more;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, The contracting for these services shall not reduce the normal and
7 regular ongoing service that the SFACC otherwise would provide; and

8 WHEREAS, A copy of the Cooperative Agreement is on file in Board of
9 Supervisors File No. _____; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Executive Director of
11 the SFACC, to execute, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, the
12 Cooperative Agreement with Presidio Trust to authorize SFACC to provide animal
13 control and welfare services for an initial term of five years, with option to extend for an
14 additional five years; and

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFACC may enter into any modification of the
16 Agreement that the SFACC Executive Director determines, in consultation with the City
17 Attorney, are in the best interests of the City, are necessary and advisable to effectuate
18 the purpose of the Agreement or this Resolution, do not materially increase the
19 obligations of the City, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including the
20 City's Charter and applicable laws; and

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Cooperative Agreement
22 being fully executed by all parties, SFACC shall provide a copy of the final agreement to
23 the Clerk of the Board for inclusion in File No. _____.
