7	collaborative study of prevention for HIV-positive persons under the first year of an	
8	award from the DHHS Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC); for the period	
9	of September 30, 2001 to September 29, 2002.

11	WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant from CDC for the conduct of a 3 year	
12	collaborative study titled "Prevention for HIV-Positive Persons"; and,	
13	WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of CDC, UCSF, and SFDPH to	
14	participate in this project; and,	
15	WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$241,549 for the	
16	first year of the award; and,	
17	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH to enter into a	
18	subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of	
19	Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as	
20	if set forth fully herein; and,	
21	WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$24,645;	
22	now, therefore, be it	
23	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract	
24	agreement in the amount of \$241,549 with UCSF, the primary contractor; and, be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
2	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position		
4	created under the agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position, which would terminate when		
5	the agreement expires.
