LANDMARK DISTRICT DESIGNATIONS

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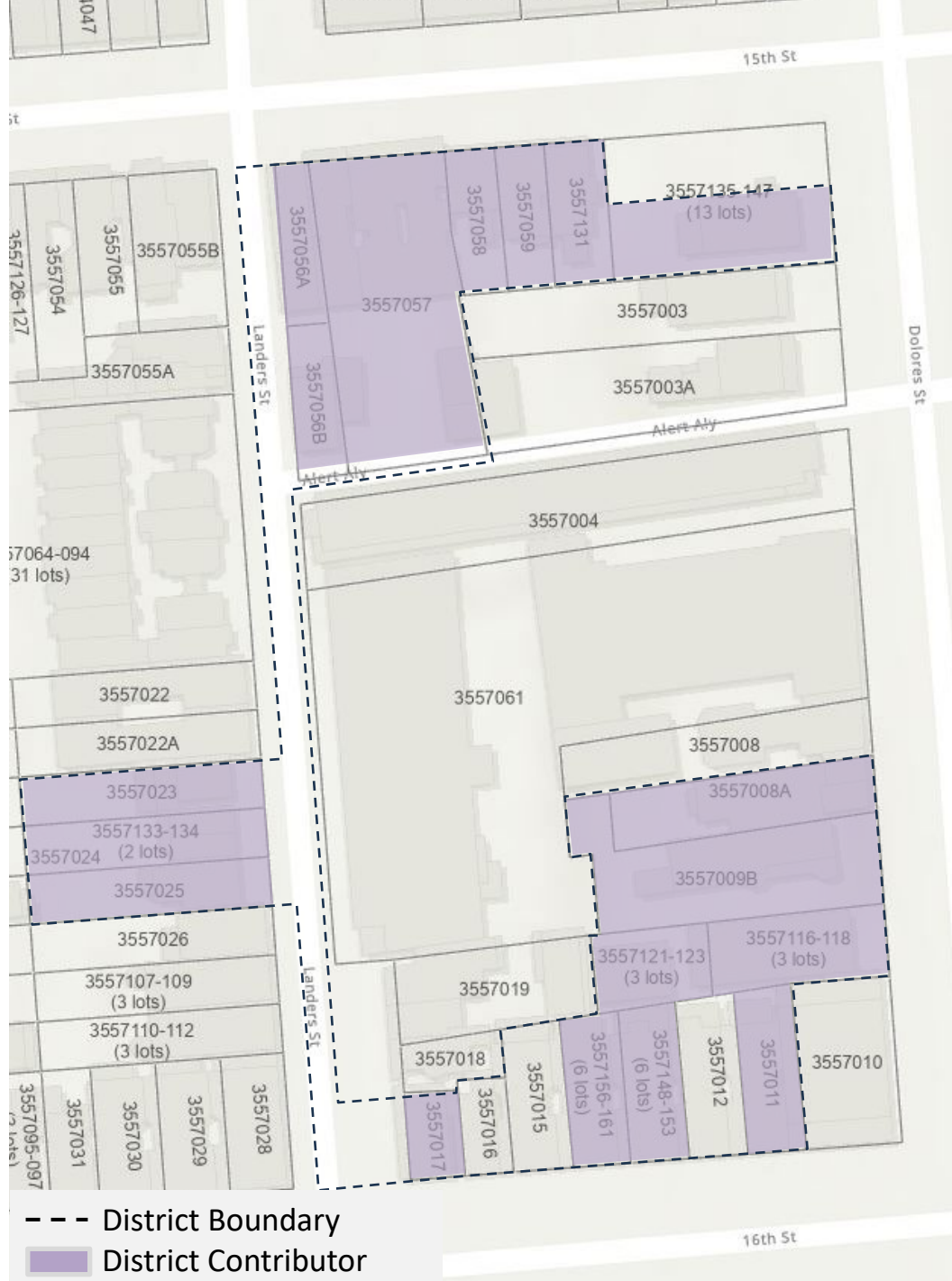
ALERT ALLEY EARLY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

Centered on Alert Alley and Landers Street, between 15th, 16th, and Dolores streets, the district is a representative collection of pre- and post-earthquake residential buildings built in the Italianate, Classical Revival, and Queen Anne architectural styles.

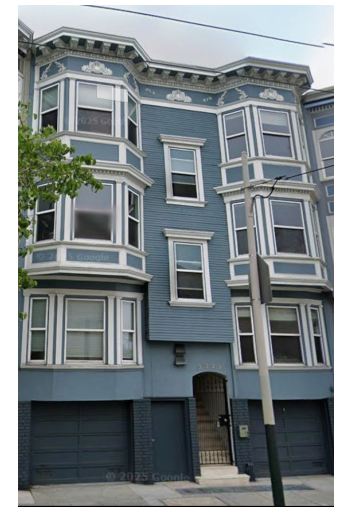
District comprised of 21 buildings:

- 17 contributing buildings/resources (81%)
- 4 non-contributing buildings/resources (19%)

Period of Significance: 1890-1910



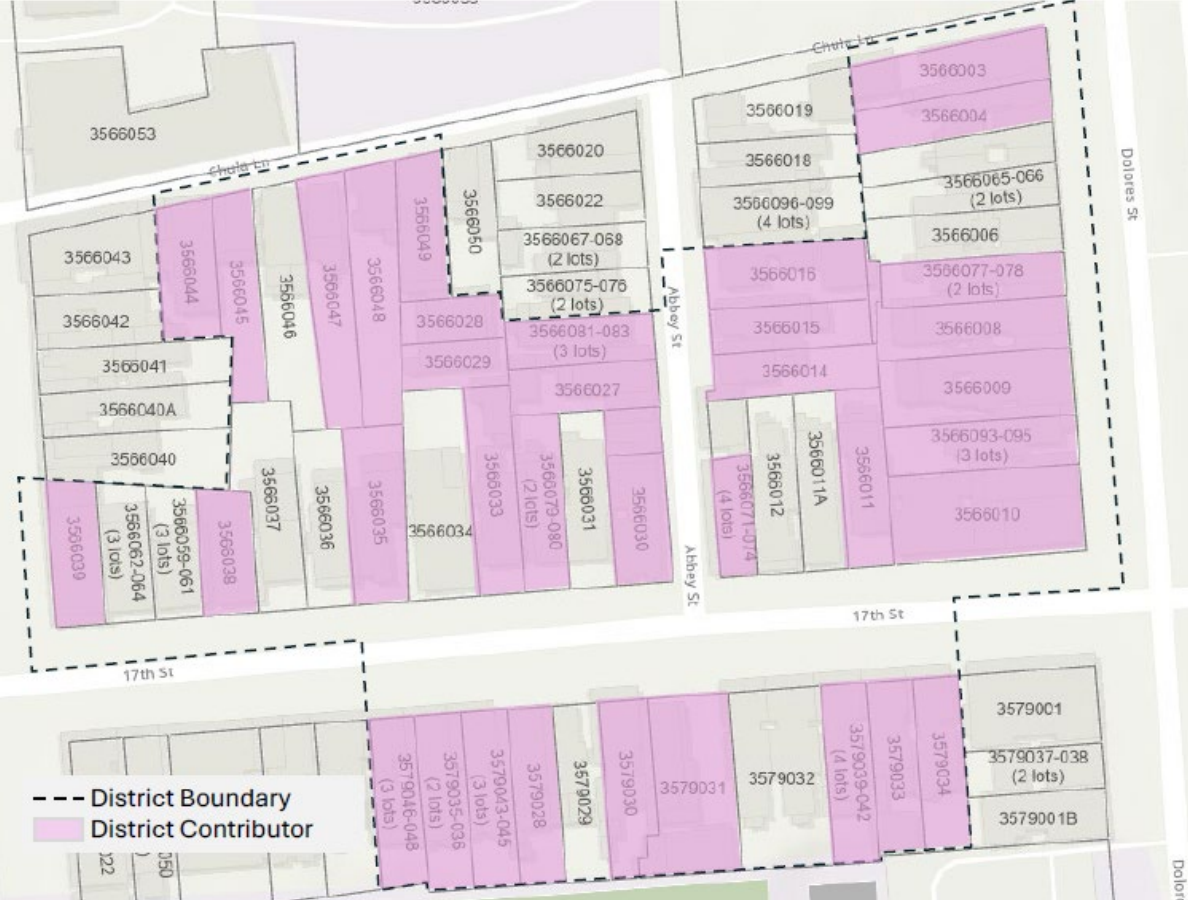
1925-1929 and 1931 15th Street

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CHULA-ABBEY EARLY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT

Centered on Chula Lane, Abbey Street, and 17th Streets, the district is a representative collection of pre- and post-earthquake residential buildings, plus two mixed-use buildings, built in the Folk Victorian, Italianate, Classical Revival, and Queen Anne architectural styles.

District comprised of 52 buildings:

- 37 contributing buildings/resources (71%)
- 15 non-contributing buildings/resources (28%)

Period of Significance: 1865-1910

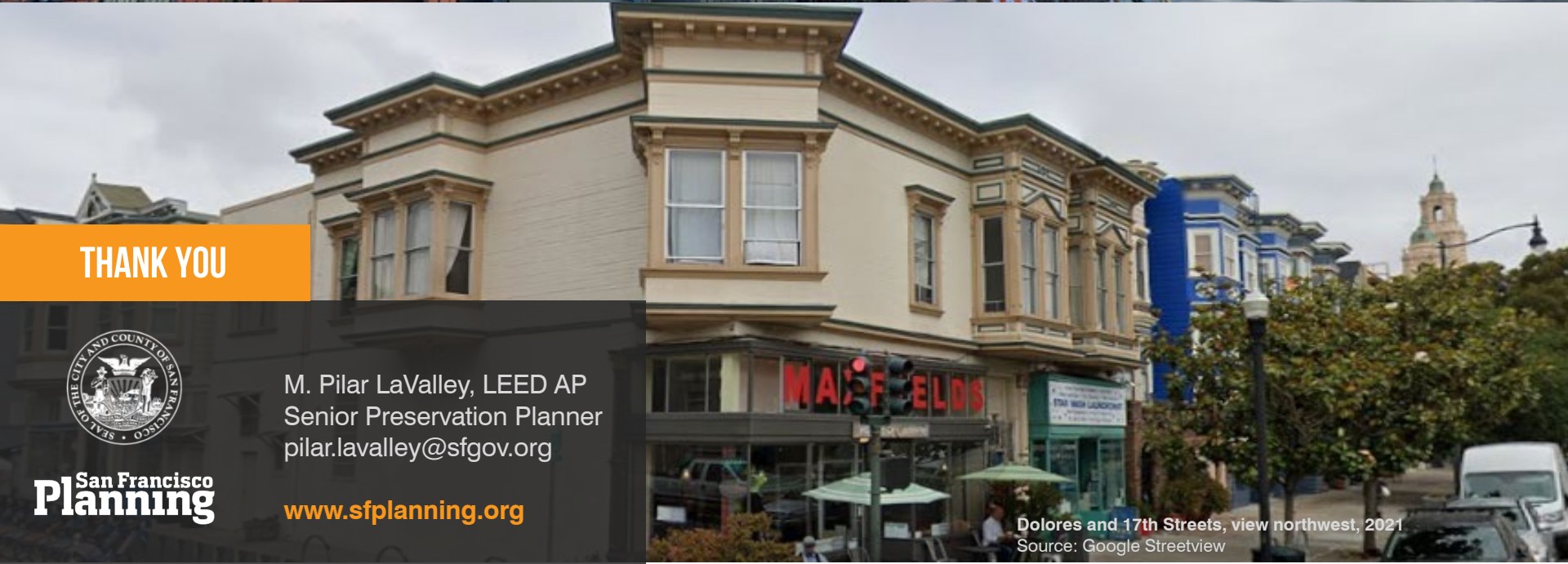
