[STATE GRANT]

RETROACTIVELY APPLY FOR AND TO
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL (MCJC) TO ACCEPT AND
EXPEND FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$771,180 FROM THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE
PLANNING (OCJP), STATE OF CALIFORNIA, TO IMPLEMENT A COORDINATED ANTI-DRUG
ABUSE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM .

WHEREAS, on December 8, 1998, OCJP awarded the MCJC of the City and County of San
Francisco \$771,180, under the Anti-Drug Abuse Enforcement Program, to implement a coordinated local
effort aimed at the apprehension, prosecution, adjudication, supervision, and treatment of drug offenders in
the City and County of San Francisco; and,


WHEREAS, on August 28, 1998, the City and County of San Francisco authorized (Resolution
No. 675-98) the MCJC, the Police Department, the Sheriff, the District Attorney, the Public Defender, and
the Adult and Juvenile Probation Departments to develop this comprehensive plan for drug abatement; and,


WHEREAS, it is anticipated that this drug abatement program will continue during the next two
fiscal years ending in 2001 as grant funds will continue over the next two years based on federal
appropriations and it is requested that this resolution approves and authorizes MCJC to apply, accept and
expend accordingly;

WHEREAS, the entire award by the OCJP funds direct services, it is requested that indirect costs
be waived; now, therefore, be it

retroactively apply for and to
RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MCJC to apply,
accept and expend \$771,180 from the OCJP, State of California, to support the Anti-Drug Abuse
Enforcement Program this fiscal year and for the following two fiscal years subject to federal
appropriations.




