

1 [Contract to fund a drug research study.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to enter**
4 **retroactively into a new subcontract from the Public Health Foundation Enterprises,**
5 **Inc. (PHFE) in the amount of \$95,851 to fund a drug research study; for the period of**
6 **March 1, 2007 through May 31, 2008.**

8 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of
9 Health to develop and conduct a research study to utilize mirtazapine to reduce
10 methamphetamine use among men who have sex with men (MSM) to reduce the sexual risk
11 of HIV transmission; and,

12 WHEREAS, PHFE has agreed to reimburse DPH \$95,851 for the fifteen month term of
13 the project, from March 1, 2007 through May 31, 2008, and the agreement may be renewed,
14 based upon an evaluation by PHFE and DPH as warranted by the need to assure appropriate
15 completion of the study; and,

16 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required, because funds will support one
17 existing position, 2232 Senior Physician Specialist (.27 FTE); and,

18 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$13,806; and,

19 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds, PHFE requires DPH to enter
20 retroactively into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of
21 the Board of Supervisors in File No. 070793, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
22 resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into an agreement
24 for \$95,851 with PHFE, the primary contractor; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
2 agreement for the period of March 1, 2007 through May 31, 2008; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
4 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
5 agreement expires.
