

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Office of Emergency Services to accept and expend a grant**
4 **in the amount of \$1,824,467 from the California Governor's Office of Homeland Security**
5 **for emergency response equipment, training, and exercises.**

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7 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco emergency response agencies
8 require specialized equipment, training and exercises to respond to potential terrorist attacks
9 using weapons of mass destruction; and,

10 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, is
11 providing financial assistance for the purchase of such specialized equipment, training and
12 exercises through the Homeland Security Grant Program; and,

13 WHEREAS, The California Governor's Office of Homeland Security has been
14 delegated responsibility for the administration of these funds within California and grant funds
15 are available from the Governor's Office of Homeland Security for emergency response
16 equipment; training and exercises, now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the Office
18 of Emergency Services to accept and expend a State Homeland Security Grant Program
19 grant of up to \$1,824,467 from the California Governor's Office of Homeland Security to fund
20 the purchase of emergency response equipment and to support specialized training and
21 exercises for the City and County of San Francisco; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of the Office of Emergency Services is
23 hereby authorized and empowered to execute, deliver, and perform, in the name of the City
24 and County of San Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and
25 payment requests necessary for the purpose of securing such State Homeland Security

1 Program grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable
2 grant application.
