

1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant and amend Annual Salary Ordinance, FY 2008-2009.]

3 **Ordinance authorizing the police department to retroactively accept and expend grant**  
4 **funding in the amount of \$1,024,467.00 from the National Institute of Justice for a**  
5 **program entitled “NIJ’s 2008 Forensic DNA Unit Efficiency Improvement Program,” and**  
6 **amending the Annual Salary Ordinance to create grant-funded positions.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco applied for  
12 funding from the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) for a certain project designated “NIJ’s 2008  
13 Forensic DNA Unit Efficiency Improvement Program” and was awarded one million twenty-  
14 four thousand four hundred sixty seven dollars (\$1,024,467); and,

15 WHEREAS, the police department will use the grant funds for the design, development  
16 and delivery of a Forensic DNA Management System (FMS); and,

17 WHEREAS, The City must enter a cooperative agreement with the NIJ to obtain the  
18 grant funds; and,

19 WHEREAS, The term of this grant award and cooperative agreement is October 1,  
20 2008 thru March 31, 2010; and,

21 WHEREAS, the grant program and cooperative agreement terms prohibit indirect costs  
22 in the agreement budget; now, therefore, be it

23 ORDAINED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County of San Francisco is  
24 authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and

1 expend funding in the amount of \$1,024,467.00 for the NIJ's 2008 Forensic DNA Unit  
2 Efficiency Improvement Program from the National Institute of Justice (NIJ); and be it

3 FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
4 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

5 FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Chief of Police, or designee, is authorized to furnish  
6 whatever additional information or assurances the NIJ may request in connection with this  
7 grant, to execute the cooperative agreement and any other agreements or documents, and to  
8 take any other steps necessary to accept and expend the grant funds; and be it

9 FURTHER ORDAINED, That the City and County of San Francisco agrees to provide  
10 matching funds required for said project (including any amendment thereof), and abide by the  
11 statutes and regulations governing this NIJ project as well as the terms and conditions of the  
12 cooperative agreement as set forth by the NIJ; and be it

13 FURTHER ORDAINED, That funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant  
14 expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors; and be it

15 FURTHER ORDAINED, That the Annual Salary Ordinance is hereby amended as
