

1 [Accept and Expend In-Kind Grants - San Francisco Public Health Foundation - Ross
2 Recreation - Playground Equipment and Materials - Bay View Playground - Valued Up to
3 \$180,000]

4 **Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept in-kind grants**
5 **from the San Francisco Public Health Foundation for playground equipment and**
6 **materials for improvements from Ross Recreation for improvements to the Bay View**
7 **Playground valued up to \$180,000.**

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9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco owns Assessor’s Parcel Block
10 No. 5420, Lot 001, known as “Bay View Playground”; and

11 WHEREAS, The City, through the Recreation and Park Department (RPD), is
12 responsible for operating and maintaining this property; and

13 WHEREAS, In 2012, Kaiser Permanente, working with Bayview community-based
14 organizations and the San Francisco Public Health Foundation, established the Bayview
15 Health Eating Active Living (HEAL) Zone to support active programming in the Bayview
16 neighborhood; and

17 WHEREAS, To support the HEAL Zone goals, the San Francisco Public Health
18 Foundation secured two in-kind grants of playground equipment and materials from Ross
19 Recreation with a combined value of \$180,000, which it intends to give to RPD, to support
20 improvements to the Bay View Playground (“Project”); and

21 WHEREAS, In 2016, the in-kind grants were set to expire and to prevent loss of these
22 grants, the San Francisco Public Health Foundation secured two credits for equipment and
23 materials with Ross Recreation with a combined value of \$180,000, which it intends to gift to
24 the RPD for the Project; and

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1 WHEREAS, On October 17, 2019, the Recreation and Park Commission adopted
2 Resolution No. 1910-005 recommending that the Board of Supervisors authorize RPD to
3 accept and expend the in-kind grants of playground equipment and the materials credits,
4 which have a combined total of approximately \$180,000 (the "Grant"); and

5 WHEREAS, The Grant terms prohibit indirect costs in the grant budget; and

6 WHEREAS, The Grant will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance;
7 now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the RPD General Manager to
9 Accept and Expend the Grants from Ross Recreation to support the purchase of playground
10 equipment and materials for the Project; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives the inclusion of
12 indirect costs in the grant budget; and

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the RPD General
2 Manager, and his or her designee, to conduct all negotiations, and execute and submit all
3 documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment
4 requests and so on, related to the Grant that may be necessary for the completion of the
5 Project.
