

1 [Grant to increase outreach, enrollment, retention and utilization efforts for Medi-Cal and  
2 Healthy Families.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Children, Youth and their**  
4 **Families (DCYF), to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$180,498**  
5 **from the California Department of Health Services (DHS) to support the Outreach,**  
6 **Enrollment, Retention and Utilization (OERU) project and to enter into an agreement for**  
7 **the use of these funds; for the period of December 13, 2006 through June 30, 2007.**

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9 WHEREAS, San Francisco was among 20 counties to receive a funding allocation from  
10 DHS – Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch for OERU activities to increase the number of children  
11 enrolled in Medi-Cal and Healthy Families programs in the amount of \$180,498 for the first  
12 year of the three year project; and,

13 WHEREAS, While annual funding amounts are subject to legislative approval and  
14 annual state appropriations, DHS has agreed to pay DCYF \$288,678 for years two and three  
15 of this project; and,

16 WHEREAS, DCYF, as the fiscal intermediary, is partnering with the San Francisco  
17 Community Clinic Consortium (SFCCC) to act as lead entity, and in order to offer services in  
18 the target neighborhoods, SFCCC is subcontracting with NICOS Chinese Health Coalition,  
19 Mission Neighborhood Health Center, Community Health Programs for Youth, and South of  
20 Market Health Center; and,

21 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, DHS requires the City to enter  
22 into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
23 Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_; which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
24 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

25 WHEREAS, the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

1           WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$12,635; now,  
2 therefore, be it

3           RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a  
4 grant in the amount of \$180,498 from the DHS – Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch; and, be it

5           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of DCYF is authorized to enter into the  
6 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

7           FURTHER RESOLVED, That DCYF is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
8 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,  
9 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1.
