WHEREAS, AB 1475 designates a portion of the federal transportation safety funds received by the state be dedicated by local governments to improving school area safety, including such projects as new crosswalks, pedestrian and bicycle paths, bike lanes, construction of new sidewalks, and traffic calming programs in neighborhoods near schools; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco supports Assembly Bill 1475, the Safe Routes to School Bill of 1999, and urges the state legislature and Governor Davis to approve the bill as soon as possible.
