

1 [Teeter Plan Extension - City College Parcel Tax]

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3 **Resolution extending the Teeter Plan to the parcel tax levied for the San Francisco**
4 **Community College District under the City College Parcel Tax.**

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6 WHEREAS, State law allows the Board of Supervisors to adopt a vehicle for the
7 allocation and distribution of property taxes and tax sale proceeds (California Revenue and
8 Taxation Code Sections 4701 et seq.), the object of which is to simplify the tax-levying and
9 tax-apportioning process and increase flexibility in the use of available cash resources
10 (“Teeter Plan”); and

11 WHEREAS, In 1993, in Resolution No. 830-93, the Board of Supervisors resolved to
12 adopt the Teeter Plan for the allocation and distribution of property tax levies and collections
13 of tax sale proceeds; and

14 WHEREAS, State law also allows the Board of Supervisors to extend the Teeter Plan
15 for the allocation and distribution of assessments that are entered on the secured tax roll for
16 any assessment levying agency in the county (California Revenue and Taxation Code Section
17 4702.5); and

18 WHEREAS, In November 2016, pursuant to San Francisco Ballot Proposition B, the
19 voters of San Francisco approved the “City College Parcel Tax”; and

20 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors will levy this special assessment for the
21 purposes specified in the City College Parcel Tax; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, By the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco as
23 follows:

24 Section 1. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

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1 Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby extends the Teeter Plan for the allocation
2 and distribution of the City College Parcel Tax.

3 Section 3. The extension of the Teeter Plan to the City College Parcel Tax shall
4 remain in effect unless otherwise discontinued in accordance with applicable law.

5 Section 4. The officers and employees of the City, including the Controller, Treasurer,
6 and Office of Public Finance, and their respective designees, are hereby authorized and
7 directed to do any and all things necessary or advisable to effectuate the purpose of this
8 Resolution, and all action previously taken by such officers consistent with this Resolution are
9 hereby ratified and approved.

10 Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption.

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
